

Pursuant to Article 20, Paragraph 1, in connection with Article 15, Paragraph 1, Item 4 of the Energy Law ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", No. 84/2004) and Article 12 of the Statute of the Energy Agency of the Republic of Serbia ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", No. 52/2005),

At the 150th session held on February 24, 2011, the Council of the Energy Agency of the Republic of Serbia passed the

DECISION
on the Amendments to
the Criteria and Standards for Setting Energy License Fee

1.

In Criteria and Standards for Setting Energy License Fee ("Official Gazette of RS", № 14/06, 40/06, 126/07, 120/08 and 32/2010), in Section I. Type and Scope of Regulatory Activities of the Agency, Item 5, paragraph 3, subitem 1), first subindent shall be amended and read as follows:

- "electricity generation with total installed capacity of over 1MW, electricity and heat energy production in CHPs of installed capacity of over 1MW, electricity transmission, transmission system management, electricity market organisation, trade in electricity for the purpose of tariff customers supply, electricity distribution;"

2.

In Section III. Technical Characteristics of Energy Facilities, i.e. Capacities or Specific Conditions for Conducting Certain Licensed Activities, under Item 7, in the table, the criteria and coefficients of energy activities under 1 and 2 shall be amended and read as follows:
